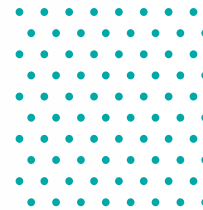

Artistic Dreams International (ADI) is a nonprofit organization based in New York City that has been delivering programming to Harlem Public Schools (elementary and middle) during school time and after school since 2011. We also serve Public Library locations on Saturdays. In Mexico we hold programs in elementary schools and middle schools.

We have served 2,250 children directly since 2011 and about 4,000 indirectly (during art exhibits and art festivals). We offer more than 435 hours of subsidized programming per year.

Our mission is to nurture youth 6 to 15 to become world citizens who transform their lives and their communities through the arts. Our values are to educate children to become creative decision makers who are inclusive, tolerant, culturally competent, world-aware and civically minded in order to create equality and peace in our world.

The objective of the **Artistic Dreams International Summer Camp** is to bring international youth together to create bonds of tolerance, equality, friendship and peace. Art is the vehicle to bring children of the world together in a fun yet educational way.

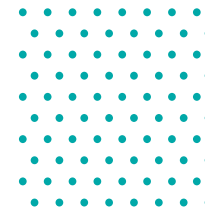

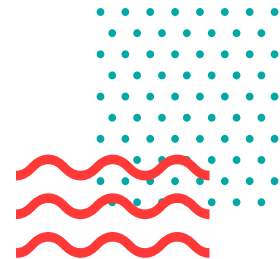

CULTURAL EXCHANGE

All children will get to have contact, conversations and create art with children from the other two countries.

Camp consists of two weeks of programming in 3 different dates to choose from. This program is the same for all three options except for Guest Artist Workshop, that changes guest artist every week



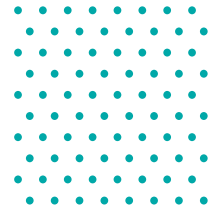

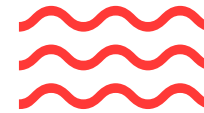
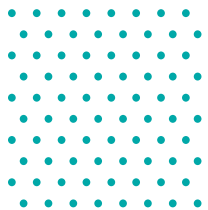


ARTISTIC DREAMS TEACHERS

EVALUATION REQUIREMENT

Since our funding to subsidize programming depends on several United States Foundations, we are required to evaluate all children with a short electronic survey before and after each two-week summer camp.

MEDIA WAIVER REQUIREMENT

All parents enrolling their children into virtual summer camp must agree to grant **ADI** permission to record and use class images (still or moving) for marketing purposes. This requirement needs to be checked off during registration. The purpose of this policy is so that Artistic Dreams International can be able to use imagery for marketing and funding purposes, solely to further develop and sustain our nonprofit program. ADI will never use or give images to any third parties outside our organization. If you do not wish your child to appear in recordings or screen shots, please have them turn off their video camera during camp (although the point of camp is for them to have direct contact with children of other countries).

VIRTUAL SAFETY AND MONITORING

An **ADI** administrator will be present in all classes and at all times to monitor child behavior. We ask all children to keep conversations school-appropriate. Children who break behavior rules will be dismissed from camp. We also block any person from sharing screens or drawing on the screen during class hours. Only teachers can do this with children of other countries).
